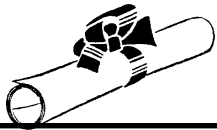
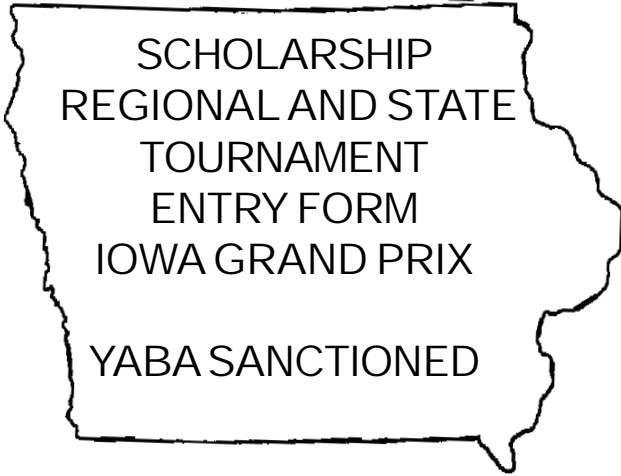

# GRAND PRIX SCHOLARSHIP REGIONAL, STATE TOURNAMENT INFORMATION AND RULES

All Youth participants will receive scholarship points for each entry to Regional Qualifiers and or State Finals. Sanctioned by YABA.

## General Playing Rules:

1. Must be currently registered in the Grand Prix Scholarship Program.
2. Two divisions both handicapped at 95% of 220. Divisions based on entering average: "A" - 139 and under, "B" - 140 and above.
3. Entering average is highest current average with a minimum of 3 league sessions. If none then use previous season final average, minimum 3 league sessions. Every participant has the responsibility to bring a copy of current league standing sheet or average verification with them, signed by the coach or proprietor.  
Average on entry form must be average indicated on verification or standing sheet. (One average sheet is sufficient for several members from the same league, if it is their highest average.)
4. Alternates allowed at State Level only. An alternate must come from the regional tournament where the opening occurs.
5. Entry fee is \$15.00 for each tournament, payable with entry form. Re-entries at Regionals are an additional \$15.00. State Finals entry fee is \$15.00, due by May 30, 2003.
6. Bowlers may receive only one Scholarship award per tournament.
7. Requested squad times will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Check in one hour prior to squad assigned.
8. Cancellation refunds only by telephone, to on site "Tournament Director," at least one hour prior to squad time so that spots may be re-assigned.  
Walk-in entries accepted with either telephone confirmation or check-in at least one hour prior to squad time, provided spots are available.
9. All bowlers must wear suitable attire, such as: Shirts, slacks or dress jeans/shorts. Bowling shirts are preferred, T shirts will be allowed, but must be plain with no printing unless it is a bowling T shirt. No hats.
10. Entries must reach the Iowa Bowling Proprietors Association, 2518 Clarkson Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50310 at least 10 days before the scheduled tournament to get the preferred squad time. All other entries will be classified as "Walk-In" entries.

## Regional Qualifying Rules:

1. 2002-2003 will feature 4 Regional Tournaments:  
October 5 & 6, 2002 - Family Bowling Center, Fort Dodge  
November 2 & 3, 2002 - Cadillac Lanes, Waterloo  
April 5 & 6, 2003 - Comet Bowl, Charles City  
May 3 & 4, 2003 - Bowlerama Lanes, Des Moines
2. Bowlers may participate in all four, and re-enter, with additional entry fee, if squads are available. Grand Prix point(s) will be earned with each entry.
3. Both divisions will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes, adding handicap based on 95% of 220.
4. 1 of 3 bowlers and all fractions will qualify to advance to the State Finals.  
At least 1 of 4 receive scholarship money at the Regional level.  
A bowler may qualify for the State Finals only once from each Regional Tournament - but must notify the tournament director upon completion of final squad of the May Regional if he/she intends to bowl more than once in the State Finals.  
Any ties - both bowlers will advance.
5. Alternates may advance to State Finals - See General Playing Rule #4.

## State Finals Rules:

- Format - 3 games with handicap on 1 pair of lanes.
1. The State Finals will be bowled at Super Bowl, Forest City, on June 7 & 8, 2003.
  2. Qualifiers should send their entry forms and \$15.00 entry fee by May 30, 2003.
  3. Check-in at least 1 hour prior to squad time.
  4. Average used will be highest 2002-2003 final average of at least 9 games or 3 league sessions.
  5. State Finals has \$1000.00 added prize money plus \$8.00 per entry. Bowlers may receive only one scholarship award. Payback is at least one in four using the same percentage or proportion as regional.

## Scholarships:

Participant must stay in the program through High School Graduation or money earned in Scholarships goes back to the program.
