RELEASE WAIVER

Applicants under age 18 must have parent or guardian complete Parts "A" & "B", 18 and over complete Part "A" only. PART "A" - WAIVER & RELEASE FROM LIABILITY

In consideration of being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (herein defined as the areas to which admission by general public spectators is prohibited and in addition, consisting of the planned route, or any other area which the participant chooses to access by any mode of transportation), or being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or any purpose participate in any way in the event, EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, acknowledges, agrees and represents that he has, or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect such restricted area or areas and all portion thereof which he enters and with which he comes in contact, and he does further warrant that his entry upon such restricted area or areas and his participation, if any, in the event constitutes an acknowledgement that he has inspected such restricted area and that he finds and accepts the same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purposes of his use, and he further agrees and warrants that if, at any time, he is in or about restricted areas and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted

HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the Iowa Sports Foundation, d/b/a Iowa Games, its affiliated clubs, the National Sports and State Governing Bodies, Iowa State University, the State of Iowa, the City of Ames, Story County, the City of Boone, Boone County, and every other city, county municipality, or governmental entity in which an event or activity shall be located, their respective administrators, officers, directors, representatives, agents, coaches, the promoters, hosts, other participants, operators officials, any persons in a restricted area, sponsors, advertisers, owners and leasees of premises used to conduct the event and each of them, their officers and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "releases" from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise while the undersigned is in or upon the restricted area, and/or competing, officiating in, observing, or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event;

RULES:

- 1. Entrants must be a resident of lowa.
- 2. Entrants must be current member in good standing with the USBC or must apply for a tournament participation card for a fee of \$5.00 prior to entering the lowa Games competition. **This tournament is USBC certified.**
- 3. This tournament is sanctioned by USBC (United States Bowling Congress), and will be governed by the rules of this organization when the Games Rules do not include the issue.
- 4 Should a bowler be eligible to participate and win a State SGA Finals spot in more than one District, they will advance and compete only once in a Handicap and/or Scratch division, from the District where they have the highest average. Bowlers may advance to district as often as they qualify and squads are available.
- 5 Your age on January 1, 2022, determines your tournament division.
- 6. AVERAGES USED will be your current certified league average (21 games minimum) as of League Qualifying date, AND/ OR enter the Scratch Divisions. You may enter both divisions as long as you enter in two different leagues. Non-league bowlers will be assigned an average, male 170; female 165; junior 8 and under, 100; 9 thru 14, 140; 15 and older, 160; unless you had an average during the prior 5 years that exceeded these assigned averages.
- 7. Ties at the Center Roll-Off and at the District Roll-Off will advance.
- 8. ENTRY FEE \$2.00 per contestant for each league. Contestants pay a bowling fee at the Center Roll-Off. Entry Fee for the District Roll-off will be \$25.00, to include bowling and a T-Shirt. There will be no additional fees for those advancing to the State Finals.
- 9. There will be 13 handicap divisions and 5 scratch divisions for both male and female:

- 11. Qualification will be based on the following Format
 - <u>1ST ROUND LEAGUE QUALIFYING</u> Pins over/under current average (21 game minimum). Entry fee of \$2.00. Advance 1 in 3 and any fraction. ENTRY CLOSING DATE: MARCH 31, 2022
 - **2ND ROUND CENTER ROLL-OFF** Must be completed by April 10th. Bowl 3 games with handicap or no-handicap if you bowl the scratch division entry fee is the lineage charged. Advance 1 in 3 and any fraction.
 - <u>3RD ROUND DISTRICT ROLL-OFF</u> Bowl 3 games with handicap or no-handicap if you bowl the scratch division entry fee \$25.00. Advance 1 in 3 and any fraction.
 - <u>4TH ROUND STATE GAMES OF AMERICA FINALS</u> Bowl 3 games with handicap or no-handicap if you bowl the scratch division. The top 3 bowlers in each division will be awarded GOLD, SILVER & BRONZE medals. No entry fee.
- 12. Handicap will be 100% of 220 in the Center Roll-Off, District Roll-Off, and the SGA Finals for the Iowa Games.
- Claims for errors in scoring must be made to a Tournament Official no later than 10 minutes after completion of bowling. (State Finals only)
- 14. Any bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning in the frame then being bowled. Score 0 points for all missed frames.
- 15. Questions not covered by these Tournament rules shall be decided by the Tournament Director.
- 16. Tournament Director (Center Roll-Off and District Roll-OffHost Proprietor) has the right to refuse any or all entries. Decisions of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is submitted in accordance with USBC.
- 17. The State of Iowa and/or any Association/Establishment, or Official connected with the Iowa Games assumes no responsibility for injury or accident to any of the participants.
- 18. USBC Rule 319 a and 319 d will not apply. USBC Rule 319 e (tournament average rerate) will apply.
- 19. It is the responsibility of the bowler to make sure that his/her own average is correct.(Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average.)
